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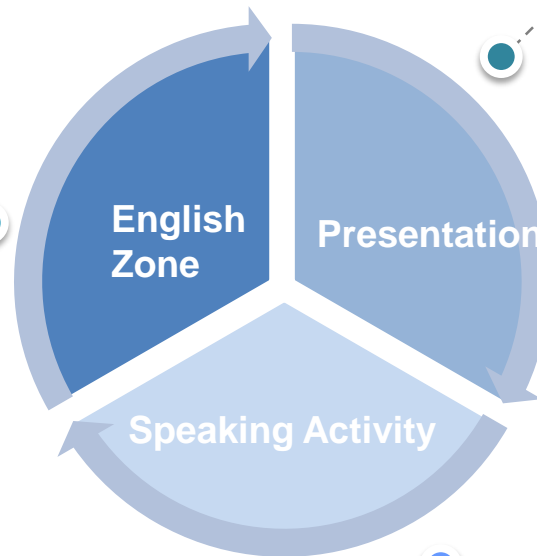
1. Curriculum (Speaking Policy)

English Zone Policy

Everyone should speak only in English for efficient and fast improvement in English Zone.

- English Zone : Everywhere in MK (except for dinning room-meal time and dormitory) from 8AM to 6PM for weekdays
- Penalty : mandatory self study for 1hour on weekend, 8 English Zone Polices stay

Speaking Activity Policy

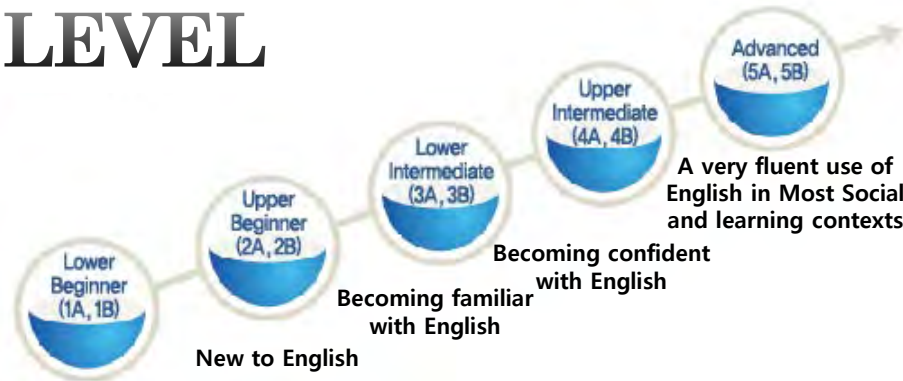
Activities with tutors on Saturdays to save time and price, and also to improve English skills.

2. Curriculum (Total 10 Level)

LEVEL



We apply MK's own curriculum to improve students' efficient study. MK has 10 Levels and it usually takes 1 month to 1 level up.

Basically, MK level system is consist of 5 levels from **Level 1 to Level 5**, each level is subdivided into 2 steps of **A,B**. **Students need taking tests, attendance and examined by Supervisors to level up**

| ESL | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Designed to help students maximize their improvement in English communication skills through 1:1 and 1:5 classes in a short period - Students attend classes according to their levels for each category of English (Listening, Speaking, Reading, Grammar, Writing). - Consist of 3~7 hours of 1:1 classes and 0~3 hours of 1:5 classes a day |
| TOEIC | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Specialized course for students who need to study for TOEIC which is either educational purpose or occupational requirement - Consists of 6 hours of 1:1 classes - For those who comply with all the rules and regulations, a free 4 week ESL course is provided if they did not achieve the target score |
| IELTS | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Specialized course for students who plan on studying in or emigrating to such English speaking countries as the U.S., Australia, or Canada - Consists of 6 hours of 1:1 classes - For those who comply with all the rules and regulations, a free 4 week ESL course is provided if they did not achieve the target score |
| TOEIC SPEAKING | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Specialized course for students who need to study for TOEIC Speaking for educational or occupational purposes - Consists of 4 hours of 1:1 classes plus 3 hours of 1:5 classes - For those who comply with all the rules and regulations, a free 4 week ESL course is provided if they did not achieve the target score |
| TESOL | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Specialized course for students interested in teaching English or working in the English education field - Consists of a special course plus 8 hour classes on Saturdays for 4 weeks (total of 32 hours) - Applicants are required to pass a diagnostic exam and an interview to qualify for the course. a WVSU TESOL Certification is issued for those who completed the course. |
| University Course | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Specialized course for students who study in a Philippine university as an Exchange student - Consists of a special course plus 1 to 3 hours of classes provided by the college - Through attending classes from CPU, students can not only improve English skills but also acquire credits which are credited by their own school. A CPU Certification is issued for those who complete the short course. |
| Internship Course | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Specialized course for students who want to learn practical English and obtain working experiences in an international company for their future career - Consists of 4 hours of 1:1 classes and 3 hours of 1:5 classes, or 4 hours of 1:1 classes and 3 hours of internship program - Companies: CPU, Iloilo City Hall, Philippine Tourism Bureau, Philippine Airlines, Iloilo Airport, Ford, Mitsubishi, SM Mall, Robison's Mall, Hotel Del-Rio, Hotel Sarabia |

| <p>Guardian Course</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Designed for young learners under 13 years old staying with their guardian(s) - Consists of a special course or a guardian course (4 hours of 1:1 classes) for guardian(s); Junior Basic=5 hours of 1:1 classes or Junior Intensive=7 hours of 1:1 classes for kids |
| <p>Supervised Study Abroad</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - designed for young learners under 13 years old staying without the guardian - consists of 5 hours of 1:1 classes and 2 hours of evening classes - 3+1 bed room, the student is supervised and looked after in terms of school and every day lives on behalf of the parents. |
| <p>Junior Camp</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Designed for young/junior students who need to study English and Math during the vacation, and want to experience various cultural activities - Consists of 4 hours of 1:1 classes, 2 hours of group classes, 2 hours of sports activities, 1 hour of math problem solving, 3 hours of evening class - Volunteer activities & outdoor activities on the weekends, including a 2 night trip to Boracay & island hopping |
| <p>1:1 Class</p> | <p>The best form of classes which is customized to lead, manage and teach students individually and which has advantages of encouraging students to focus on the class and improve students' study skills.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - This form of classes can be applied to all parts of lessons |
| <p>1:5 Class</p> | <p>This form of classes can help students focus on others' opinion so that they can learn from other students' expressions better than other forms of classes. Also this can prevent from talking about personal issues.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - This form of classes are best for conversation part even though it can be applied to all parts of lessons. |
| <p>Special Class</p> | <p>Free optional class- Students can choose the class. Ex) New TOEIC, CNN Listening, Presentation, debate, Grammar</p> |
| <p>Self Study</p> | <p>Every Monday to Thursday. Review, Preview, Homework, personal study.</p> |
